Student’s photograph taken must wear formal Mahidol University uniform only and do not wear eyeglasses, and● <u>A scanned National I.D. card with certified true copy of the card in jpg format- for Thai student.</u> Size of scanned I.D. card should not exceed 2 MB or A4 size.● <u>A scanned passport with certified true copy of the passport in jpg format- for non-Thai student.</u> Size of scanned passport should not exceed 2 MB or A4 size. <p>Note: After 7-day uploading, you have to check whether your uploaded files of photograph/ scanned National I.D./ scanned passport are accepted. If not, you will be asked to re-upload them. You may periodically check the approval status of your uploading by logging into your account.</p>
